Run our CN Phatudi Campus Cafeteria/Tuckshop [Sekhukhune TVET College Graduate Empowerment Programme]

The Centre for Entrepreneurship Rapid Incubation in association with the Sekhukhune TVET College has to introduce a programme to lease out the CN Phatudi Campus Cafeteria/Tuckshop to former or exiting students of the college. It's a one-year renewal contract opportunity, based on performance. This programme is for unemployed youth (18-35) that are graduates or exiting the Sekhukhune TVET College and also residing in and around Sekhukhune.

Applicants are required to send a business proposal not exceeding 10 pages that demonstrate sustainability and potential success even after the college contract lapses. The proposal should consist of the CV of the key persons running the site and also their creative menu or offering with proposed prices. Having your own start-up capital and equipment will be advantageous.

Successful applicants will be linked with the Sekhukhune TVET College – Centre for Entrepreneurship Rapid Incubator for mentorship and business development support, however will be subject to a 3 months' probation before the contract is signed. Applicants will have to report monthly on their progress and the centre will undergo quarterly audits and site visits to ensure the site is as per the report and that the facility is kept at acceptable standards.

The successful applicant will receive training and capacity building, access to the college populace as the primary market, incubation, assistance with marketing & seed funding and affordable rental space. The contract may be renewed, only if the business performance is deemed satisfactory.
